The Routt County Conservation District is searching for an independent contractor to manage the implementation of a large Grazing Lands Conservation Initiative Grant which will further develop a virtual fencing program in Routt County. This person will need excellent organizational and communication skills, along with record keeping, computer and time management skills. Duties will include; timely filing of progress reports, monthly reports to the district board, purchasing of equipment utilizing proper protocols, planning of educational events, supervision of a range technician and assuring the compliance of all operations to the grant specifications. Previous experience with grant implementation and /or range management is helpful. The position is part-time, year-round, with variable hours estimated to average around 10 hours per week, 50 weeks per year. Base pay is \$35/hour, but may vary depending on experience. The Grant is currently scheduled to last for 2 years. This independent contractor will report to the Routt County Conservation District Board, and be supervised by the boards Virtual Fence GLCI Grant subcommittee.
