The Routt County Conservation District is searching for a contract Range Specialist to aid in the implementation of a Grazing Lands Conservation Initiative Grant which will further develop a virtual fencing program in Routt County. This person will need excellent organizational and communication skills and have the technical ability to develop a monitoring program to assess the effectiveness of virtual fencing in promoting good resource and soils management and assist ranchers in developing grazing plans and utilizing virtual fence technology. The position is full time/seasonal with an approximate season of May-October. Base pay is \$25/hour but may vary depending on experience. This grant is currently scheduled to last 2 years. This independent contractor would report to the Project manager, and the Virtual Fence GLCI Grant subcommittee of the District Board.
